Check these prerequisites carefully as they must be met prior to the start of the AI/OWSI/IDC

- Emergency First Response CPR and First Aid Instructor (or equivalent rating) taken within the past 24 months.
- Certified as a PADI Divemaster, Assistant Instructor (for OWSI) or current instructor member in good standing with another recreational diver training organization for at least 6 months
- 100 logged dives (Prior to the PADI Instructor Exam)
- PADI Open Water, Advanced, and Rescue Diver certifications (or equivalent ratings).
- **Current Medical Statement signed by a physician within the past 12 months**
